## Gospel Discussion

### “The Conversation with the World”



#### Highlight Scripture

##### Mark 16:15

“And he said to them, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.”



#### Explain (Give context)

Have you had something so exciting to share that you couldn't wait for the world to find out? Is there anything that would keep you from telling everyone? As believers in Jesus, we have the most exciting news EVER and it is our job to tell everyone. John 3:16 explains it perfectly, “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.”

So, who do we tell the “Good News” to? In Mark chapter 16 verse 15, Jesus gives His final instructions to His disciples and to us, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.” We tell EVERYONE! Your friends, family, enemies, teachers, and the outcasts. “For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him” John 3:17.

So how do we start the conversation about Life & Death with the world? Today, we have another Help Tool that will get the conversation started and help us share the Gospel with all creation, just as Jesus instructed.



#### Apply

Choose today that you will share the Gospel with those people in your world that don't know Jesus. Take the Life/Death card and begin with the word “Death” showing. Read the top of the card, “For the wages of sin is death”. Then flip the card clockwise to show the word “Life” and read the top of the card, “But the gift of God is eternal life.” Next, read the verses on the back as you continue to share the Gospel. Begin a conversation about why you are a Christian and the Good News of Jesus.



#### Respond (Groups of 3-5)

Get into groups and pray for God to give you boldness to begin the conversation about Jesus with the world. Then take turns sharing the Life/Death card with your group.



#### Bottom Line

The only way the world will know about Jesus is if you tell them.
