Evangelism Panel

Prior to Prepare Week, select a panel of 4-8 leaders who have the most experience in sharing Christ with others and living out their faith publicly. Set 4-8 chairs in front of the club and have them sit in them. The Prepare Week host can lead almost like a live TV show host and take charge of the program and discussion. Pass out a note card to each student and ask them to think of a question about how to be most effective for Christ on your school campus and turn that in to the Prepare week host as the discussion goes on.

If no good questions are asked, simply go down the lineup and discuss what you think is the most effective way to live for Jesus at school.
